



Collect & Dispose Service – WEEE Regulations

At Price Transport we continually review our services to ensure compliance and best practice in our industry.

Definition of Service

On selection of Collect & Dispose (C&D) service, we will collect a piece of equipment destined for disposal. Where this item is of electrical nature it is subject to meeting requirements of WEEE (Waste Electrical & Electronic Equipment) Regulations.

Partner

Our current recycling partner is Colwicks Ltd, based in Nottingham. We have regular bulk collections from our sites in Barnsley, Felbridge and Bristol. Colwicks are responsible for the full disposal process and certification. Unless otherwise requested by a customer, our agreement is for all units to be stripped for parts eligible for recycling and then scrapped. They will not be sold for B grade or repair / refurbishment.

Documentation

A Waste Transfer Note will be generated for a Collect & Dispose request and taken to the collection by the driver. This note details all Company registration numbers as directed by the WEEE regulations, alongside basic details required for the collection. The driver will complete details on collection, including classification and packaging of the waste. Both the consignee at the collection point and the driver must sign and complete their details. A copy of the Waste Transfer Note will be available on our portal for you to provide to your customer as necessary.

A further Waste Transfer note will be completed for the bulk collection from our site on collection from Colwicks. Colwicks will complete this Waste Transfer note through to the point of disposal and provide us with a certificate of conformity for each load. A copy of this note will also be uploaded to our portal for each unit on the corresponding load.

Due to the importance of the correct paperwork, we may not be able to collect for disposal if not previously arranged before the driver has attended site.

Conditions

Due to the equipment being destined for disposal, we appreciate that the equipment will generally not be in good condition or suitably packaged for transport. We will collect items not on a pallet, but would request that customers ensure the unit has been emptied (including of fluids), secured as much as possible and with no protruding / sharp parts. Our teams have the right to refuse collection of a unit that is deemed dangerous or likely to cause injury.



Pricing

Please refer to your rate card for the current surcharge for our Collect & Dispose service. Please note this surcharge is an addition to the collection cost for the area and size of the unit.
